Galitt's Contactless Mobile Payment AAUI Test Tool for testing Mobile Products qualified by EMVCo

Boulogne (France), April 24th, 2013

The initial certification and on-going management of a contactless mobile payment device can be very challenging, as multiple payment applications may be loaded into a mobile device. An extra layer of complexity is added due to the various containers that are available to load and store the payment applications on the phone: a USIM (UICC), an embedded secure element residing in the mobile device, or in a microSD card that is inserted into the phone. To address these challenges, EMVCo has set up a modular approach that defines a certification process that applies to the specific components within the contactless mobile payment applications.

Thus, the EMVCo Contactless Mobile Payment (CMP) Product Type Approval process enables compliance testing of a secure element containing the payment applications that adhere to EMV[®] Specifications. In particular the EMVCo Type Approval process queries and identifies all EMV[®] applications on the mobile device via the Proximity Payment System Environment (PPSE), a mechanism for finding and presenting the available payment applications. This Type Approval process also provides the ability to check the conformance of the reference application activation user interface (AAUI) on the mobile device.

Leveraging its KaNest[®]-ICC simulator as a card test tool, Galitt implemented end of last year, the EMVCo Contactless Mobile Payment Type Approval Application Activation User Interface Test Cases to create the KaNest[®]-ICC CMP AAUI Card Test Suite.

Today, Galitt continues its commitment to developing best in class EMV[®] interoperability programs by announcing that the KaNest[®]-ICC CMP AAUI Card Test Suite has been qualified by EMVCo.
